Resolution Honoring the Life and Service of Brother Dave Eisner

- 1 **WHEREAS,** Dave Eisner devoted his entire working life to public service on behalf of the people of
2 Milwaukee County; and
- 3 **WHEREAS,** throughout his career, Dave was a committed AFSCME member who believed deeply in
4 the power of union solidarity and collective action; and
- 5 **WHEREAS,** Dave rose through the ranks of his local union to become a respected leader, earning the
6 trust of his fellow members through his integrity, determination, and unwavering
7 commitment to working people; and
- 8 **WHEREAS,** Dave stood firmly in the fight against Scott Walker’s attacks on public workers and their
9 unions, never backing down in the face of political efforts to strip workers of their rights,
10 dignity, and voice; and
- 11 **WHEREAS,** after leaving Milwaukee County service, Dave continued his life’s work in the labor
12 movement by serving at AFSCME Council 48 and later AFSCME Council 32, where he
13 kept fighting for county workers and all public service workers with the same passion
14 and dedication that defined his entire career; and
- 15 **WHEREAS,** Dave meant a great deal to new staff as they came into the union, serving as a mentor, a
16 steady presence, and a source of hard-earned wisdom; and
- 17 **WHEREAS,** Dave had an encyclopedic memory for the fights he had been involved in, carrying with
18 him the history of struggles, campaigns, and battles that shaped both the union and the
19 workers he served; and
- 20 **WHEREAS,** Dave Eisner embodied the very best of our union values: loyalty to working people,
21 courage in struggle, and a lifelong belief that workers deserve respect, justice, and a
22 strong union; and
- 23 **WHEREAS,** his life and work left a lasting mark on his union, his coworkers, and the labor movement
24 in Wisconsin; and
- 25 **WHEREAS,** Dave also loved his daughter, Jennifer, and his grandchildren deeply, was always proud
26 of them, and carried that love and pride with him throughout his life.
- 27 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the delegates to this annual convention of AFSCME Council 32
28 assembled in Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin, April 17-18, 2026, and AFSCME Council 32
29 honor the life, service, and memory of Brother Eisner, give thanks for his lifelong
30 commitment to Milwaukee County workers and all union members, and recognize his
31 legacy as one of solidarity and leadership; and
- 32 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that AFSCME Council 32 extends its deepest sympathy to Jennifer, to
33 Dave’s grandchildren, and to his family, friends, coworkers, and recommits itself to
34 carrying forward the fight for working people to which he devoted his life.
